**ACCOMPANYING QUESTION AND ANSWER WORKSHEET**

As appropriate, please suggest recommended study, test or quiz questions / answers to accompany the case study proposed above.

<b>Proposed Question</b>	In 2000, Congress appropriated \$100 million for what program led by the Library of Congress (LoC)?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	The National Digital Information Infrastructure and Preservation Program (NDIIPP).

<b>Proposed Question</b>	What does the LoC do?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	Maintaining records that archive historical or cultural collections as well as collections subject to mandatory archival under U.S. copyright law.

<b>Proposed Question</b>	What did the NDIPP legislation call on the LoC to do?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	Lead a public-private partnership in the development of a national approach to digital preservation. To collect, preserve, manage, and make available significant digital content, especially information that is created in digital form only, for current and future generations.

<b>Proposed Question</b>	What are the seven sustainability factors developed by the LoC?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	Disclosure, adoption, transparency, self-documentation, external dependencies, impact of patents, and technical protection mechanisms.

<b>Proposed Question</b>	What are the four basic content categories initially adopted by the LoC?
<b>Proposed Answer</b>	Still images, sound, text, and moving images.
